\rightarrow	Lecture: Post WWII beginnings, Schuman Declaration May 9, 1950 [European Day], Council of Europe 1955 [European Flag], Council of Europe 1972 [European Anthem], European Union 2000 [EU Motto]

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4 small groups, each assigned to one of the 4 symbols: European Day, European Flag, European Anthem, and EU Motto. Conduct in-depth research and discuss the history, purpose, design, and effectiveness of each symbol.

Assessment

- → 20-minute group PowerPoint presentation to the class on their assigned symbol. Include pictures, video, and one short interactive activity with the class.
- → 1. History of the symbol
- → 2. Purpose and goals of the symbol
- → 3. Artistic period influences in the design, composition and/or execution of the symbol.
- → 4. In what ways has the symbol been successful? Provide examples.
- → 5. In what ways has symbol been criticized, critiqued, or ignored? Provide examples.
- → 6. If you were a consulting team hired by the EU to recommend ways to increase the effectiveness and use of the symbol, what would be your recommendations?
